Contest Rules and Information

Only conventional brass band instruments are to be used in all classes.

Winners will be responsible for engraving their own trophy, keeping it polished and returning it for presentation at the following year's contest.

No player may enter a class more than once.

It is the responsibility of competing band secretaries or group leaders to ensure that good behaviour is maintained throughout the day by all competitors and that younger competitors are appropriately supervised.

The areas immediately close to the adjudication area(s) must be kept quiet at all times.

Rooms used for rehearsal must be under adult supervision at all times.

A 'No Smoking' policy applies inside the building and in its grounds.

No games are to be played outside or around the school.

Competitors will be advised of their draw within ten days of the closing date. **Because of the number of competitors needing to be scheduled we cannot accept late entries.**

An official accompanist will not be provided; if required, competitors must make their own arrangements. There will be a piano (main theatre) and a keyboard with pedals (library) supplied for your use.

Music for Adjudicator

Competitors must provide unmarked copies of their Solos, Duets and Quartets and present them to the room assistants prior to competing.
